The HLT Showstoppers are youth members of Highlands Little Theatre interested in all aspects of producing theatre for youth by youth. They are guided and advised by adult HLT members.

## **WHAT DO YOU DO?**

When not preparing for a performance, we meet once a month. Workshops are conducted at the meetings covering different theatre topics. Some of the topics in the past included "How to Prepare for Auditions", "Stage Basics", "Memorizing Lines" and "Conquering Stage Fright".

We have members as young as 5 yrs. and up to 18 yrs.



## **WHEN DO YOU PERFORM?**

In December 2006, the ShOwStOpPeRs produced their first play, *A Modern Christmas Carol*. We've also performed at National Kids Day, the Zenon Awards Show, A Night on Broadway, and the Fine Arts & Crafts Festival. Requests for appearances continue to come in. HLT will be producing two children's plays, *Cinderella Wore Combat Boots*, and *The Super Secret Casserole* in May 2008.

**DO I HAVE TO BE A PERFORMER?** No. HLT is dedicated to teaching all theatre skills, including costuming, makeup, lighting and sound.



**DO I HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF HLT? WHAT DOES IT COST?** Yes, you have to be an HLT member to participate in the youth theatre group. Membership is \$25 for individuals, and \$45 for a family up to four. Your membership includes supplemental accident insurance whenever you are participating in an HLT event, and a monthly newsletter. Membership dues are prorated for first time members joining after July 1st to \$12 individual and \$30 for family. Please see the membership brochure for more information.
